General Landscaping Notes:

Bi-weekly mowing in all zones has been completed on a weekly basis. Pruning team onsite Monday-Thursday.

The Pruning team finished Zone 7. Crew is on site Monday, Tuesday, Thursday this week and currently working in Zone 8, we will be finishing zone 8 at the beginning of next week and then move on to Zone 1.

- **Zone 8 pruning in progress.**
- **We are currently spot mowing in dry areas to avoid damaging turf, and only edging where needed. These precautions are taken during dry season in order to maintain the health and beauty of Bell Tower Park**

Below is the summary of this month's review of the Bell Tower Park Community:

*Bi-weekly mowing and hard edging and soft edging. The pruning team is in process of completing zone 8. Not every plant will be touched during every pruning cycle. Greenscapes will prune plants based on their growth pattern in their natural shape to prolong their lifespan.

Special Projects:

- **Community palm pruning complete**
- **Ficus trimming 90% complete, will be finished the week of 1/6.**

***Fertilizer:**

- **Quarter 1 Fertilization = 5.16.24 (Completed)**
- **Quarter 2 Fertilization = 8.21.24 (Completed)**
- **Quarter 3 Fertilization = 11.20.24 (Completed)**
- **Quarter 4 Fertilization = 2.19.25 (Plant and Turf)**

***IPM:**

- ***Last app completed on 12.1.24***
- ***Next app = 2.1.25***

IPM stands for integrated pest management, which is the practice of only using chemicals that are necessary when needed, they are targeted to specific weeds that are present. For weed control, it is a liquid that is sprayed on the turf, once it is dry (usually within an hour of application), it becomes inert and is not harmful to pets or humans. For pest control (white fly, mealy bugs, etc.) we do not perform blanket treatments, it is only applied to plants that have an infestation problem.
