



**MEETING TOOK PLACE ON MARCH 6, 2025 IN THE BTP CLUBHOUSE
MINUTES TO BE REVIEWED AND APPROVED AT APRIL 3, 2025, MEETING**

BUSINESS DISCUSSED: Nina went over some highlights of the new website including what information renters and the public are required to see as per Florida statutes and what they do not have access to see.

Thursday, March 13th at 7:00 P.M. in the Annex, the Committee will host a "Meet the Candidates" event. Nina will be the host, and Kathleen will be in charge, passing the microphone to those who need to speak.

Saturday, March 8th, from 10:00 A.M. to 12:00 P.M., Nina, John F., and John S. will be in the Clubhouse to help residents sign into the new website and/or provide training to those who desire assistance.

The Bell Tower Notes II Newsletter will be eliminated in its current form and become a blog on the new Bell Tower Park website. As articles are written, they will be added to the site and shared with the community.

Ron explained that the POA and the 3 sub associations are required to have a website. At the present time, all four are still part of Frontsteps, but some are slowly moving to the new RGB website. Cost to each association will be around \$1,200 to switch over to RGB and leave Frontsteps. The goal, in the future, would be to eliminate Frontsteps and use the BTP website exclusively.
