

BELL TOWER PARK LANDSCAPE COMMITTEE ENTRANCE END-CAP UPDATE

Hi There Everyone,

Wanted to fill-in all the Bell Tower Park Owners on the progress we are making on our entrance-landscaping project.

On Wednesday 21st we received 24 various variety agave plants in 3- and 7-gallon sizes! Friday the 24th we went to Plant City, loaded picked up, and returned with 1,500 1-gallon Asian Green Jasmine plants. Today we (*Barb Moccia, Sue Niknejad, my friend Sal and I*) unloaded the Jasmine and distributed them on the end caps to be planted. GreenScapes will position and plant the Agave and Jasmine on Tuesday Morning. And, with that we will have reached a stopping point on our Entrance Beatification Project.



Next, on our list is to work on the boundary with the county property at the east end of the boulevard! We will see multi-color bougainvillea delivered and planted on Monday the 9th of June. Then it is break time for a while, where we will go into "maintenance mode".

We also plan an experiment with a variety of colors of Creeping Thyme. The plan is to use seed to hopefully cover the mulch on the inward bound side of the Owner's Entrance. Don't know how it will work out, but we will see. If it does, it is a very inexpensive way to cut down on the mulching required each year. Again, after seeing results we have several places where this plant and others like it can be used in a "once and done" fashion.

In the fall, depending on how severe the hurricane season is, we plan to work on the front wall. Currently the plan is to use clumping, non-invasive bamboo to block the building and US-41 from our view.
