

JANUARY 2, 2026 - DROUGHT NOTICE

Hello residents;

Our area is experiencing a drought.

Most areas of BTP have had the irrigation running. As we speak there are two area pumps having issues and are being worked on.

As we progress through the dry season, (long-term forecasts are negative for any useful rain) the county MAY introduce restrictions on our usage, often limiting irrigation to one day a week - not enough to keep the lawns green; they will go dormant and begin to brown out. The good news is they generally come back with adequate rainfall.

How can we help???

Handheld watering is usually exempt; therefore, if residents would voluntarily take 15 minutes and go out with a hose a couple of days a week, it may just be enough to keep areas that you can reach around you green.

I think anything we can do to help will help and will be greatly appreciated by all.

It takes a village. While it was nice to avoid tropical storms and or hurricanes this summer, that lack of water is now an issue complicated by no rain of consequence since about October 27th.
